- The Olympic Rings: You can find the giant rings for the perfect “hero” photo op.
- The London Aquatics Centre: Children can actually swim in the same pool where heroes like Ellie Simmonds won their medals. It’s open to the public and very affordable.
- Tumbling Bay Playground: A huge, nature-inspired play area with rock pools and sandpits that kids this age adore.
- ArcelorMittal Orbit: The giant red twisting sculpture. While the slide is for older kids (8+), you can still enjoy the view from the top.

Draw/paint a picture of your favourite Olympic sport.

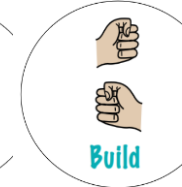


### **Oracy Ideas**
