Each week, I will be sent home with 3 of my CGP homework books. I will be set:

- 2 pages of Maths
- 2 pages of Spelling
- 2 pages of Reading

My homework pages will be linked to my learning that week. I will bring this home each Thursday and I need to complete it and have the books back in school by the following Tuesday. 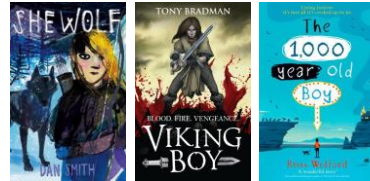
### Places to Visit
