

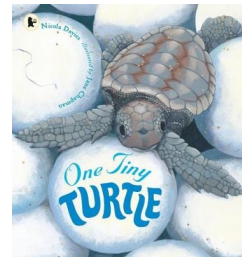
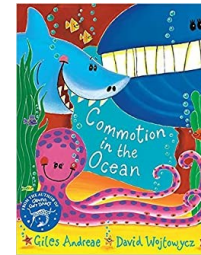
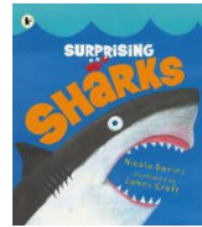


Commotion in the Ocean

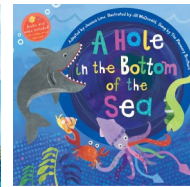
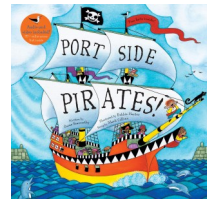

Personal, Social, Emotional Development

Throughout the unit Changing Me we will be exploring our bodies. We will be naming some of our body parts and talking about what we need to do to keep them healthy. We will also be learning that we all grow from babies to adults.

In preparation for our transition to Year 1, we will be looking at how to express our feelings; talking about our worries and the things we are looking forward to. Finally, we will be celebrating our memories of being in Reception.

Expressive Arts and Design

We will be immersing ourselves deep into the colours and patterns of the ocean. The children will have the opportunity to explore a variety of materials, tools and techniques, experimenting with colour, design, texture, form and function. Using these skills we will create our very own habitats to reflect their learning about the ocean.

Understanding the World

What is an ocean? What would you find in an ocean? What is the difference between a shark and a whale?

We aim to explore these questions throughout this topic to build our understanding of the world around us and the importance of protecting our planet.

We will use the scientific skills of identifying, classifying and grouping as well as using secondary sources to find the answers to our questions.

Physical Development

PE will continue to be on a Monday. We will play games such as rounders to develop our hand eye coordination as we learn to use various bats and racquets to hit a large ball. We will do this by aiming & throwing objects underarm and catching a balloon/bean bag/scarf & sometimes a bouncing ball. We will also focus on moving and stopping safely in a specific area.

We will be focusing on handwriting practise to ensure that we are using the correct pencil grip and forming letters correctly.

Communication and Language

This term we will continue to practise our Oracy skills to help build our conversational and listening skills. During these sessions we will answer questions, for example would you rather go to an alien school or have an alien teacher, and provide our reasons why by using the word 'because'. We will also have to listen to our peers to understand their choices too!

Literacy

We will continue to consolidate our phonics learning this term, focusing on reading longer words and using phase 4 blends with more confidence. We will apply our phonics to our writing, thinking about extending our ideas into more detailed sentences. In reading we will focus on our comprehension of texts, asking different questions to check our understanding of what we have read.

We will be writing for different purposes as well as using descriptive words to give more detail. Children will sequence and retell stories as well as being given opportunities to write their own stories based on our chosen texts.

Maths

This term we will consolidate our understanding of the number 10, developing our fluency and recall with number bonds to 10. We will build on our knowledge of addition and subtraction, introducing larger numbers and mathematical language. We will also take time to consolidate previous learning in preparation for Year One. We will be exploring a measurements in a range of ways. We will be looking at how to measure water, length and weight.
