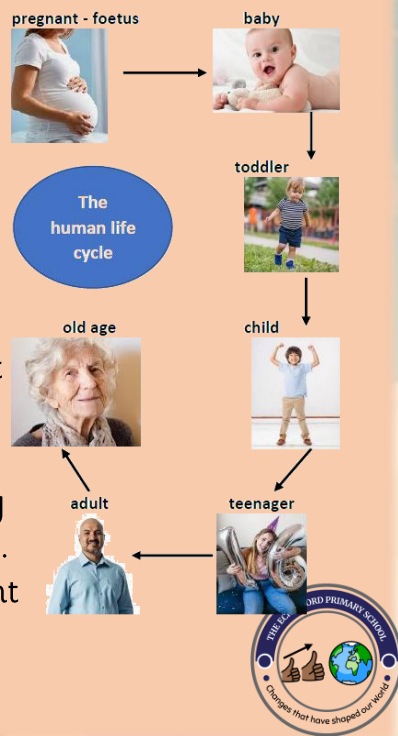


Science:

History:

- Ancient Greece began in 625 BC and lasted until its fall in 476 AD.
- The ancient Greeks left a long standing mark on the modern world by developing new government systems called democracy.
- Democracy meant all citizens voted on the laws.
- The Olympics began in Ancient Greece, originally designed as a religious festival honouring Zeus. The games were named after their original location of Olympia.
- The first Olympic games were held in 776BC.
- Ancient Greeks invented:
 - the basis of geometry.
 - The concept of democracy.
 - They also invented the alarm clock.

- A pilgrimage can be a physical journey but it can also represent an individual's journey of faith.



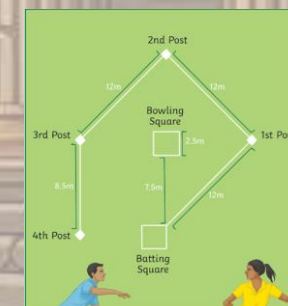
PE:

Basketball:

- Technique for defending: On your toes, knees slightly bent ready to catch or intercept the ball. Keep close to your opponent. Make sure you are always ball side. Mark in a sideways stance so you can see the player and the ball.
- Technique for attacking: Create space by changing speed, changing direction and driving (sprint) into the space.

Rounders and Cricket:

- Fielders must attempt to retrieve the ball and throw it to the nearest base or wicket to run the batter out.
- When bowling, stand sideways to the target. Your throwing arm is taken back behind the body and then swings forward keeping the speed the same.
- To catch under pressure, stand with feet shoulder width apart. The palms of your hand should be together and your arms and hands should be in front of the body with head still and eyes level. Watch the ball drop into the softest part of your relaxed hands and wrap fingers around the ball.
- To win a game, you must use your teamwork and communication skills.

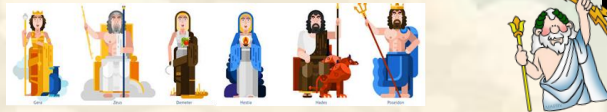


PSHE:
