- **Chichester Harbour & Dell Quay (West Sussex)**- there are lots of opportunities for rock pooling at low tide and crabbing at Dell Quay.
- **Portsmouth Historic Dockyard (Hampshire)**- You can explore **The Mary Rose & HMS Victory**, two famous ships.

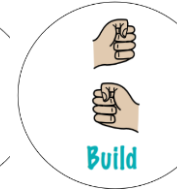


Oracy Ideas
