Computing – Programming

For Example: Pine, Fir, Holly, Cedar.

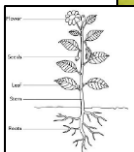
The **stem** holds the plant upright

Example of common **flowers**: daisy, sunflower, rose, dandelion, buttercups.

The differences could be: Size, shape, height, colour, where they grow, if they are wildflowers or need planting.

Gymnastics:

Climb safely, showing some shapes and balances when climbing.

Roll in stretched/curled positions e.g. 'log'.

Striking and Fielding:

Show some different ways of hitting, throwing and striking a ball.

Hit a ball or bean bag and move quickly to score a range of points.

Timbre is the quality of a sound made by a particular voice or musical instrument.

A rhythmic pattern is when a series of sounds or notes are repeated in a pattern.

An instrument or rhythm pattern can represent a character in a story.

My voice can create different timbres to help tell a story.
