Our PE is on a Thursday.

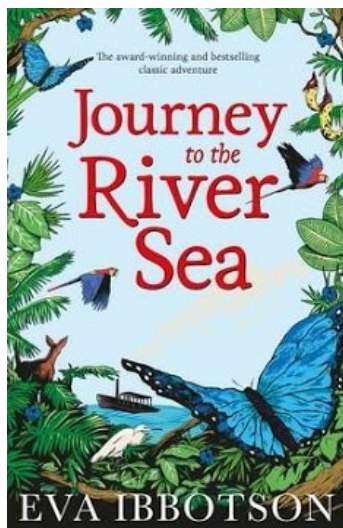
This half term we will be developing our skills in dance, gymnastics and invasion games. We will also begin indoor athletics.
