

Expressive Arts and Design

What materials do we need?




Literacy

We will continue to consolidate our phonics learning this term, focusing on reading longer words and using phase 4 blends with more confidence. We will apply our phonics to our writing, thinking about extending our ideas into more detailed sentences.

In Reading we will focus on our comprehension of texts, asking different questions to check our understanding of what we have read.

We will be exploring lots of different adventures in this topic, and will use these as inspiration for our writing, creating our own adventure stories that are sequenced appropriately.

Maths

This term we will be exploring numbers beyond 20, depth of number and number bonds. The children will be given opportunities to explore place value and solve problems using these concepts. We will also take time to consolidate previous learning in preparation for Year One.
