Computing



This half term we will be writing a programme introducing the understanding of variables. We will demonstrate these skills to create a game show based on Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf.

English

We will be using *Mouse, Bird, Snake, Wolf* by Dave McKean and *Odysseus* by Hugh Lupton to inspire our writing. We will focus on a range of writing objectives to develop a variety of writing styles and skills.

Topic

This half term we will have a History focus on the Ancient Greeks and how their lifestyle contributed to the development of the Western World, including the Olympics. Who will be victorious, not only in our History learning, but in our games?

RE
